

Did You Know...

CCHT Recertification

- ▶ NNCC begins sending notices out to our certificants 120 days prior to their expiration date
 - Make sure NNCC has your current contact information.
- ▶ CCHT certification needs to be renewed with NNCC every three (3) years to maintain national certification.
- ▶ There are two (2) options for recertification
 - Recertification by examination.
 - It is recommended that an exam application be submitted a minimum of three (3) months prior to expiration.
 - Recertification by continuing education
 - 30 contact hours specific to hemodialysis must be obtained within the current three (3) year certification cycle.
 - 3000 hours of work experience as a hemodialysis patient care technician must be completed within the current three (3) year certification cycle.
- ▶ Recertification by continuing education takes approximately 6 to 8 weeks for processing.
 - We recommend submitting a recertification application at least two (2) months prior to expiration.
- ▶ If certification **is not** maintained with NNCC, you will no longer be nationally certified and may no longer use the CCHT credential.
 - If you switch to a state certification program, you will be required to retest with NNCC to become nationally certified as a CCHT again.
 - State certification programs are only good in the state in which you are certified.
- ▶ Verification of current certification should be obtained by searching the NNCC certified directory at www.nncc-exam.org.
